



Perfect labelling solutions for
microbreweries

The "Skagen Bryghus" microbrewery was founded in 2005 in Skagen's former power station at Kirkevej 10, and is situated very close to the city centre.

The master brewer explains

At Skagen Bryghus we brew special beers according to our own recipes. We produce a standard range of approx. 20 different types of beer. The old machine hall - which once produced power for all of the residents of Skagen - today houses a wonderful German Kaspar Schulz brewing system, which produces a very special beer every day in accordance with all of the rules of the art of brewing: "Skagen Bryg - With warmth, feeling and soul." The brewery restaurant is fitted with a long mahogany bar with 24 taps. The brewery's debut beer was named "Drachmann" and was highly successful.



We are very satisfied with the new labelling machine. It is the perfect solution for our beer bottles.

» **Compact solution for labelling on the cap and around the side**



In 2017, a new product was distilled at the brewery - the "Ølsnaps" (or beer brandy in English). Depending on type, this beer brandy is aged in old sherry or bourbon barrels, or in new French oak barrels.

In 2017, Skagen Bryghus brewed a total of 320,000 litres of beer. The new labelling system was extremely helpful here. The installation of the labeller was simple - the machine was ready for operation after just three days. Only minor conversion work was necessary in the brewery itself.

The labels are now applied before filling, which saves time and money in the production process. In this way it is possible to label up to 1,800 beer bottles with a 0.5 litre capacity every hour. "The machine has been running faultlessly since its installation and we are very satisfied", enthuses the master brewer.

Every beer is different and has its own label. Changing the labels is very easy and takes place quickly. With a volume of 4000 litres, which roughly equates to 8000 bottles, we only need to change the label roll 3 to 4 times during production.



What is a microbrewery?

The term microbrewery refers to house beer or craft beer breweries. These are tiny breweries, which account for the lowest level in the classification of breweries by production volume in the German-speaking region. Up to and including 2005, the Federal Statistical Office attributed up to 5,000 hectolitres to the group, whilst the smallest group has produced up to 1,000 hectolitres since 2006.
